

I) Jesus Redeemed Us from the Curse of Sin to the Blessing of Life

A) Psalm 107:1-2 – Redeem (heb) – purchase, deliver, to buy back a relative's property

v.2 – Jesus redeemed us out of the enemy's control into the Blessing of God.

- 1) We must know and say what we are redeemed out of and into if we are to walk in our redemption blessings.

B) Galatians 3:13-14,29 (AMPC) – Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law to the blessing of Abraham.

v.13 – Christ redeemed us from the curse of sin and spiritual death.

- 1) **Romans 5:12** – First curse to come on man was spiritual death – separation from God.
 - a) **Genesis 2:15-17** – surely die – dying spiritually you will die physically. Man became more than a sinner; he died spiritually and was separated from God.

v.13 – Christ redeemed us from sin, spiritual death and separation from God.

- 1) **II Corinthians 5:21** – Jesus took our sin nature upon Himself.
 - a) **Isaiah 53:6** – The Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
- 2) **Hebrews 2:9** – Jesus tasted death – spiritual death – separation from God for all of us.
- 3) **I Peter 2:24** – Jesus bore our sin, spiritual death and sins, on the cross.
 - a) **Hebrews 2:14-15** – Jesus in His death, burial and resurrection delivered us from sin and death.

v.14 – **Now Every Believer Can Walk in the Blessing of Righteousness**

- 1) **Romans 5:6-11,17** – We in Christ are now reconciled, saved, made righteous. (**v.17**) – We are now to reign in this life through Christ Jesus.
- 2) **II Corinthians 5:17-21** – We are now righteous new creations in Christ.
vv.18-20 – God now calls us into the Ministry of Jesus to go in our right standing in God and continue the works of Jesus. We are to bring God's message of reconciliation to all people.
- 3) **Acts 1:8** – We can now receive the Holy Spirit and walk in the same power Jesus had and do His works to set people free.
