

- I) Jesus Redeemed Us from the Curse of Sickness to the Blessing of Health
- A) Psalm 107:1-2 – Redeem (*heb*) – purchase, deliver, to buy back a relative's property
Jesus not only saved us, He purchased for us all our property we lost in the fall.
- B) Galatians 3:13-14,29 – The curse is 3-fold: spiritual, financial, physical
The purpose of Jesus' coming was to redeem us from all the curse into the full blessing of Abraham.
- 1) I John 3:8 (AMPC) – Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil. We must discern what are the works of the devil? What are the works of God?
- C) Galatians 3:13 – Is sickness a curse or a blessing?
- 1) Deuteronomy 28:15,61 – Moses says sickness and disease is part of the curse of the law.
- 2) Luke 13:10-17 – vv.10-13 – Jesus heals a woman of 18-year infirmity.
vv.16-17 – Jesus declares sickness is a curse from satan. Healing is God's blessing.
- 3) Acts 10:38 – Peter says satan is oppressor, Jesus is the Healer.
3 Witnesses – Moses, Jesus, Peter agree that sickness is part of the curse and not of God.
- D) Galatians 3:13-14,29 – One part of Jesus' work to destroy the works of the devil is to redeem us from the curse of sickness into our inheritance of healing.
vv.14,29 – We are heirs to healing because we have received Jesus as our Christ.
- 1) Isaiah 53:4-5 (AMPC) – Isaiah prophesied of Jesus' redemptive work of healing.
- 2) Matthew 8:16-17 – Jesus does what Isaiah said.
- 3) I Peter 2:24 – On the cross Jesus paid the full price for our healing.
- E) Galatians 3:29, Luke 13:16 – We are now seed of Abraham. Just like the woman, we receive healing because Jesus redeemed us and bought back for us our inheritance of healing. Healed not because we deserve it but because of Jesus giving it to us.
