Roots: What Never Changes, But How Does

1. Devotion is a concept that we struggle with in our modern culture. Where have you seen devotion in the people you spend time with?
2. In Acts 2, we saw the early followers of Jesus reflect a kind of devotion that is rare in our culture. What did this devotion look like? How did it impact their community?
3. We have a difficult time often in beginning to give an offering, usually because our faith exists emotionally and cerebrally. How might God be challenging you to implement your faith into how you manage your resources?
4. Understanding giving as an act of faithfulness and worship is not how we are prone to think about our finances. How does understanding giving as worship change the way you might approach it? What happens when you pray about how you ought to serve God through your finances and resources?
5. We explored the idea of community in terms of small groups and smaller communities this Sunday. Where do you primarily experience community? Do you have relationships that function as support systems?
6. What happens when we deprive ourselves of community? Hypothetically, what can happen if we are without community and tragedy hits us/our family?
