A. Trinity in Three Propositions

1. There is but one and true God who is eternally and immutably indivisible. (Monotheism)

2. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are each fully and equally God (The doctrine of the sameness of the essence of the persons.)

- 3. The Father, Son, and Spirit are each distinct persons (Distinctness in subsistence).
 - Each of the three persons exist distinctly in the unity of the Trinity.
