Sermon Takeaway Notes:

- Acts 19 focuses on Paul's question, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?"
- Two key gifts of the Holy Spirit are mentioned: **tongues** (speaking in different languages) and **prophecy** (encouragement through scripture or words of knowledge).
- These gifts can evoke mixed emotions and different beliefs, so it's important to approach the discussion with curiosity and openness.
- Tongues and prophecy are manifestations of the Holy Spirit experienced by many, but not by all. Personal experiences with these gifts vary widely.
- Paul's teachings in 1 Corinthians 14 guide understanding tongues and prophecy in the context of faith.

- 1. What has been your experience, if any, with the gift of tongues?
- 2. How have you experienced prophecy or prophetic words in your faith journey?
- 3. How does Paul's question in Acts 19 challenge or affirm your understanding of the Holy Spirit?
- 4. As you reflect on 1 Corinthians 14, how do you see the role of tongues and prophecy in the church today?
- 5. How can we foster open and respectful conversations about spiritual gifts in our group?
