### **Three men / Three Lessons**

#### Gaius vv.1-8

He was known as a man whose soul prospered

He built his life on the Word of God

He was generous with his <u>time</u> and <u>resources</u> in support of the ministry of the Gospel.

#### **Diotrephes vv.9-11**

He was known as a man who wanted superiority

He was a self-promoter

He was rebellious to spiritual authority

He spoke slander

He was not worthy to be a spiritual role model

#### Demetrius vv.12-14

He was known as a man to <u>pattern</u> after. He had a good <u>reputation</u> with others ...those that knew him well

... from John and his associates

He made the Gospel attractive

*The Doctrine of God* God is light.

### The Doctrine of Christ
