

Purpose: To be a Worshipper – September 3, 2017
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Today we continue our journey to understand the purpose of life. We are praying that as we continue this journey we all commit to a holy pursuit of God and His purposes for us.

Revelation 4:11, "Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you <u>created all things</u>, and by your will they <u>existed</u> and were <u>created</u>."

Matthew 22:37-38, Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment.

My Primary Purpose: to WORSHIP God.

In its simplest definition, worship is <u>loving God back</u>.

Romans 12:1, Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's <u>mercy</u>, to <u>offer</u> your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

What is Worship?

- Worship is my response to God's love.
- *Offer* from Romans 12:1 = Worship is giving back to God.
- When we worship God, it brings <u>enjoyment</u> to Him.
 - 1. Love God thoughtfully Mind
 - 2. Love God passionately Heart
 - 3. Love God practically Strength

Worship is focusing my attention on God.

Worship is not putting your mind in neutral; it's actively focusing your mind, thoughts, and attention on God.

God wants your focus because he is focused on you.

Psalm 139:1-3, You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.

 We need to learn that focusing on God means we must focus less on ourselves.

Romans 8:7, For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law.

• We have to make the choice to stop thinking about certain things and start thinking about God.

Matthew 6:6, Find a quiet, secluded <u>place</u> so you won't be tempted to role-play before God. Just be there as <u>simply</u> and <u>honestly</u> as you can manage. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace.

Isaiah 26:3, You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you.

Worship is expressing my affection to God.

1 John 4:19, We love because he first loved us.

God loved us first!

Exodus 34:14, You must worship no other gods, for the Lord, whose very name is Jealous, is a God who is jealous about his relationship with you.

God is passionate about us!

Hosea 6:6, I want you to show love, not offer sacrifices. I want you to know me more than I want burnt offerings.

God doesn't want your religious duty he wants your desire!

Worship is using my <u>ability</u> for God.

Words of worship need to be backed up with practical expressions.

Colossians 3:23, Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters.

- Worship is a life issue...who are you working for?
- God doesn't want worship to be a "church thing" he wants it to be a whole life approach to worshipping Him.

Worship should create a sense of <u>awe</u> in my life.
