ONCE UPON A TIME...

Genesis 1:1, in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. NIV

John 1:1-2, In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God and He was with God in the beginning. $_{\mbox{\tiny NIV}}$

Genesis 1:2, And the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

To understand the story, we must go to the **beginning**.

The story begins with something relational not a mathematical equation.

God makes men and women his friends in this story.

In the beginning, the love story of God begins.

He wrote **human beings** into it.

1 John 5:19, The whole world is under the control of the Evil One.

Romans 7:18-24, I realize that I don't have what it takes...I decide to do good, but I don't really do it; I decide not to do bad, but then I do it anyway. Something has gone wrong deep within me and gets the better of me every time...The moment I decide to do good, sin is there to trip me up...I'm at the end of my rope. Is there no one who can do anything for me?

God announces his **rescue mission** to save his people.

Genesis 3:15, I'm declaring war between you and the woman, between your offspring and hers. He'll crush you head. You will strike his heal. Msg

Galatians 4:4, When the fullness of time came, God sent forth his son. NIV

The life, death, and resurrection of Jesus answers once and for all the question "What is God's heart toward me?"

Jesus not only opened the door back to God, he is the door.

John 10:9, I am the door, and the person who enters through me will be saved. NCV

John 10:10, The thief comes to steal and kill and destroy, but I came to give life—life in all its fullness. NCV

1 John 3:8, The Son of Man came to destroy the works of the devil.
