Deepest Foundation for Community

Created for Community:

- Something in all our soul longs for meaningful relationship with others.
- We are created for community because we were created out of community.
- Genesis 1:26, Then God said, "Let us make human beings in our image, to be like us.
- The Trinity shows that God Himself is community.
- Our longing for community flows out of being image bearers of the triune God.

Broken Community

- Sin broke our relationship with God, but it also put a tendency to use people to meet our own needs first.
- Sin is more than just bad behavior; the Bible refers to sin as unbelief.
- Genesis 3:4-5, "You won't die!" the serpent replied to the woman. "God knows that your eyes will be opened as soon as you eat it, and you will be like God, knowing both good and evil."
- Unbelief is a failure to see and believe what's true about God and ourselves.

Redeemed for Community

- The Gospel meets us with good news, but there can't be good news without bad news.
- Sin not only separates us from God but also leads us to isolation.
- Jesus redeems us from sin and all its effects in our life.
- We are redeemed to be image bearers of God and to reflect His goodness to the world.
- God has created us for community, Jesus redeemed us for community to truly be the BODY of Christ.
