- I And Abimelech the son of Jerub<u>baal</u> went to Shechem to his mother's relatives, and spoke to them and to the whole clan of the household of his mother's father, saying,
- 2 "Speak, now, in the hearing of all the <u>lords</u> of Shechem, 'Which is good for you, that seventy men, all the sons of Jerub<u>baal</u>, rule over you, or that one man rule over you?' Also, remember that I am your bone and your flesh."
- 3 And his mother's relatives spoke all these words on his behalf in the hearing of all the <u>lords</u> of Shechem; and they were inclined to follow Abimelech, for they said, "He is our relative."
- 4 They gave him seventy pieces of silver from the house of <u>Baal</u>-berith with which Abimelech hired worthless and reckless fellows, and they followed him.
- 5 Then he went to his father's house at Ophrah and slew his brothers the sons of Jerub<u>baal</u>, seventy men, on one stone....
- 6 All the <u>lords</u> of Shechem ... assembled together, and they went and crowned Abimelech king

- 22 Now Abimelech ruled over Israel three years.
- 23 Then God sent an evil spirit between Abimelech and the <u>lords</u> of Shechem; and the <u>lords</u> of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelech ...
- 24 so that the violence done to the seventy sons of Jerub<u>baal</u> might come, and their blood might be laid on Abimelech their brother, who killed them, and on the <u>lords</u> of Shechem, who strengthened his hands to kill his brothers.
- 25 The <u>lords</u> of Shechem set men in ambush against him on the tops of the mountains, and
- they robbed all who might pass by them along the road; and it was told to Abimelech.Now Gaal the son of Ebed came with his relatives, and crossed over into Shechem; and the <u>lords</u> of Shechem put their trust in him.
- 27 And they went out into the field and they gathered the grapes of their vineyards and they trod them, and they held a festival; and they went into the house of their god, and they ate and they drank and they cursed Abimelech.
- 28 Then Gaal the son of Ebed said, "Who is Abimelech, and who is Shechem, that we should serve him? Is he not the son of Jerub<u>baal</u> ...? ... Why should we serve him?
- 29 Would, therefore, that this people were under my authority! Then I would remove Abimelech." And he said to Abimelech, "Increase your army and come out."

- 39 So Gaal went out before the <u>lords</u> of Shechem and fought with Abimelech.
- **40** Abimelech chased him, and he fled before him; and many fell wounded up to the entrance of the gate.

- 42 Now it came about the next day, that the people went out to the field, and it was told to Abimelech.
- 43 So he took his people and divided them into three companies, and ambushed them in the field; when he looked and saw the people coming out from the city, he arose against them and slew them.
- 44 Then Abimelech and the company who was with him dashed forward and stood in the entrance of the city gate; the other two companies then dashed against all who were in the field and smote them to death.
- 45 Abimelech fought against the city all that day, and he captured the city and slew the people who were in it; then he razed the city and sowed it with salt.
- **46** When all the <u>lords</u> of the tower of Shechem heard of it, they entered the inner chamber of the temple of El-berith.
- 47 It was told Abimelech that all the <u>lords</u> of the tower of Shechem were gathered together.48 So Abimelech went up ...
- **49** ... and set the inner chamber on fire over those inside, so that all the men of the tower of Shechem also died, about a thousand men and women.
- 50 Then Abimelech went to Thebez, and he camped against Thebez and captured it.
- 51 But there was a strong tower in the center of the city, and all the men and women with all the <u>lords</u> of the city fled there and shut themselves in; and they went up on the roof of the tower.
- 52 So Abimelech came to the tower and fought against it, and approached the entrance of the tower to burn it with fire.
- 53 But one woman threw an upper millstone on Abimelech's head, crushing his skull.
- • •
- 55 When the men of Israel saw that Abimelech was dead, each departed to his home.
- 56 Thus God repaid the wickedness of Abimelech, which he had done to his father in slaying his seventy brothers.
