

Ephesians 6:1-9

- 6:1** Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
- 6:2** "Honor your father and mother" (which is the first commandment with a promise),
- 6:3** "so that it may be well with you, and that you may be long-lived on the earth."
- 6:4** And parents, do not provoke your children to anger, but nourish them in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
- 6:5** Slaves, obey your masters [*kyrios*] according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of your heart, **as to Christ,**
- 6:6** not with eye-service, as people-pleasers, but **as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God** from the soul,
- 6:7** serving with zeal, **as to the Lord** [*kyrios*], and not to people,
- 6:8** knowing that whatever good each one *does*, this he will receive back **from the Lord** [*kyrios*], whether slave or free.
- 6:9** And masters [*kyrios*], *do* the same things to them, giving up threatening, knowing that both their Master [*kyrios*] and yours is in heaven, and there is no partiality from Him.
