5:24	but as the church submits to Christ, so also the wives to their husbands in everything.	
5:25	Husbands, love your wives, <i>just as</i> Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,	2. S
5:26	that He might sanctify her, having cleansed [her] by the washing of water in the word,	
5:27	that He might present to Himself the church glorious, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she might be sanctified and blameless.
