

## Ephesians 5:21-33

- 5:21** submitting to one another *in the fear of Christ.*
- 5:22** Wives [submit] to your own husbands, *as to the Lord,* **1. S**  
**5:23** for the husband is the head of the wife, *as also Christ [is]*  
*the head of the church—He [being] the Savior of the*  
*body;*  
**5:24** *but as the church submits to Christ, so also the wives to*  
*their husbands in everything.*
- 5:25** Husbands, love your wives, *just as Christ also loved the* **2. S**  
*church and gave Himself up for her,*  
**5:26** *that He might sanctify her, having cleansed [her] by the*  
*washing of water in the word,*  
**5:27** *that He might present to Himself the church glorious,*  
*not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she*  
*might be sanctified and blameless.*  
**5:28** So also husbands ought to love their own wives, as their  
own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself;  
**5:29** for no one ever hates his own flesh, but nourishes and  
cherishes it, *just as Christ also the church,*  
**5:30** *because we are members of His body.*
- 5:31** For this reason a man shall leave father and mother and **3. S**  
shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one  
flesh.  
**5:32** *This mystery is great; but I speak with reference to Christ*  
*and to the church.*
- 5:33** Nevertheless, you also, one by one—each must love his  
own wife thus: as himself; and may the wife [see] that  
she fear the husband.
