

Ephesians 1:15-23

15 For this reason, I, in particular, having heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and love for all the saints,

16 do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention [of you] in my prayers:

17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him—

18 having had the eyes of [your] heart enlightened—so that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what [are] the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

19 and what [is] the surpassing greatness of His power towards us who believe—according to the working of His mighty strength—

20 which [power] He worked in Christ, raising Him from the dead and seating [Him] at His right hand in the heavenlies,

21 far above every rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come;

22 and He [God] put all things in subjection under His [Christ's] feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,

23 which is His body, the fullness of Him [God] who fills all things in all ways.
