

Ephesians 5:1-20

- 1 5:1 Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children, 1. |
- 2 5:2 and walk in love, just as Christ also loved us and gave Himself up 2. |
- 1 5:3 But **immorality** and all **impurity** or **greed** must not even be 2. |
- 2 5:4 and [let there be no] **filthiness**, and **foolish talk**, or **coarse jesting**, 2. |
- 1 5:5 For this you know for certain, that no **immoral** or **impure** or 2. |
- 3 5:6 **greedy** person (who is an idolater) has an inheritance in the 2. |
- 3 5:7 kingdom of Christ and of God. 2. |
- 3 5:8 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these 2. |
- 3 5:9 things the wrath of God comes upon the children of disobedience. 2. |
- 3 5:10 Therefore do not be co-partakers with them; 2. |
- 3 5:11 for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; 3. |
- 3 5:12 walk as children of light 3. |
- 3 5:13 (for the fruit of the light [is] in all **goodness** and **righteousness** 3. |
- 3 5:14 and **truth**), 3. |
- 3 5:15 discerning what is pleasing to the Lord. 3. |
- 3 5:16 Do not co-participate in the unfruitful works of darkness, but 3. |
- 3 5:17 instead even expose [them]; 3. |
- 3 5:18 for it is shameful even to speak of the things done by them in 3. |
- 3 5:19 secret. 3. |
- 3 5:20 But all things, when exposed by the light, become manifest, for 3. |
- 3 5:21 everything that becomes manifest is light. 3. |
- 4 5:22 Therefore it says, "Awake, sleeper, And arise from the dead, And 3. |
- 4 5:23 He will shine on you—the Christ." 3. |
- 4 5:24 Therefore watch carefully how you walk, **not** as **unwise** persons 3. |
- 4 5:25 **but** as wise, 3. |
- 4 5:26 making the most of time, because the days are evil. 3. |
- 4 5:27 So then do **not** be **unintelligent**, **but** understand what the will of 3. |
- 4 5:28 the Lord is. 3. |
- 4 5:29 And do **not** get drunk with wine, for that is **unchastity**, **but** be 4. |
- 4 5:30 filled by the Spirit, 4. |
- 4 5:31 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, 4. |
- 4 5:32 singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; 4. |
- 4 5:33 always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus 4. |
- 4 5:34 Christ to God, even the Father, 4. |
- 4 5:35 submitting to one another in the fear of Christ. 4. |
