1. Fellowship with one another despite personal differences of opinion.
2. Do not despise one another.
3. Do not judge each other.
4. Recognize that each person is God's servant and personally responsible to God for what he allows himself to do.
5. Realize that no man will fall who follows after God according to the light that they have received.
6. Judge no man about the day they call sabbath. Galatians 4:9-11
7. Don't judge a man about what he eats and drinks. 1 Timothy 4:1-6
8. Don't make one man greater than another in your mind. Gal. 5:14-15
9. Recognize that each man will have to answer to God for himself, nobody else. Matthew 12:37
10. Let all live in peace, for the Lord and for each other. 1 Cor. 8:8-13
11. Do not cause anyone to stumble.
12. Know that according to the N.T., no animal is considered unclean. Colossians 2: 14-17
13. Demonstrate love by giving up the things which destroy others. 1 Corinthians 10:23-31
14. Do not let your freedom in Christ be a stumbling block to others.
15. Follow after the things that make Peace and edify others.
16. Practice your Faith before God and do not parade it before others.
17. Do not do anything that is doubtful. 1 Corinthians 8:7
18. Bear the weakness of others. Romans 15:1-3
