Reconciliation

This is a key word for Ambassadors.

To be reconciled means to bring back together again.

In Hebrew, The word means to be covered, make and atonement or propitiation on behalf of someone. In our legal terms, it's what happens when someone pays your fine in court and sets you free. This is what God was proposing to do with his people. they didn't know it yet, but Plans were in Motion to Pay the Ultimate fine, so we can return to Gods loving arms again.

Example of Reconciliation:

Hosea 3:1-5

(Hosea represents God, Gomer Represents His people and the ransom is represented in Christ.)

We lead non believers to Salvation (Saved through Christ)

We also need to do this first with Love, and speak the truth so that they may know the Lord. Building and living a peaceful relationship with God.
