1. By outward and general conduct. Matthew 7:15
2. By inward State. Matthew 5:22,28
3. By the kind of fruit their works produce. Matthew 7:16-20
4. By the kind of fruit in their doctrine. 1 Timothy 4:1-6
5. By professing to do, but NOT doing the will of God. Matthew 5:20
6. By their satanic backing. Matthew 24:24
7. By their destiny. 2 Corinthians 11:13-15, Revelation 19:20
