Message summary - Because God cares about renewing all creation all our labor in the Lord matters - nothing is meaningless.

Intro question - What's the first thing you did out of lockdown?

Review a few big ideas from our series . . .

What is creation groaning for? - see Romans 8.19-23

Who will sort through what is okay and what is not? - see 2 Corinthians 5.10
(And to review we're saved by what Jesus did - not our works, see a few verses below 2 Corinthians 5.18-21)

How does this world end? - see Revelation 21.1-5

Quickly review 1 Corinthians chapter 15 for details on the resurrection if you like (especially 1 Cor 15.50-57) but don't take too much time.

Focus on the last verse . . . Read 1 Corinthians 15.58
What is the "therefore" there for?
Why does everything matter?
