- To expand Christian outreach (Philippians 4:15-16)

10 Giving Principles

- 1. Giving is done in spite of our circumstances
- 2. It is not the amount that matters, it is the attitude
- 3. God must have first priority
- 4. Giving is a demonstration of our love for God
- 5. Christ is our example of a giving attitude
- 6. We need to be faithful in our giving
- 7. We need to give as we are able
- 8. There is a blessing in giving
- 9. Giving is an act of trust in God
- 10. Giving is an act of worship and brings glory to God
