- I. It is never too late for God's grace in your life.
- II. Your past is never too great for God's grace. (v9)
- III. Your identity is not in the shame of your past, it is in the beauty of God's grace. (v10)
- IV. Your purpose in life is shaped by God's grace. (v10)
- V. The resurrection of Jesus guarantees that grace wins. (v55-58)
