III. The Pattern of Leviticus

5 Main Sacrifices in Leviticus

Burnt Offering

Gain God's acceptance (atonement) and expression of devotion to God.

Grain Offering

Voluntary expression of devotion to God and acknowledging His goodness and providence.

Peace or Fellowship Offering

The joyful expression of thanksgiving that the offerer was at peace with God.

Purification or Sin Offering

To purify oneself for re-entering the presence of God.

Guilt Offering

Making reparations for one's sin. It was about making things right, especially if our sins damaged someone else.
