Discussion Questions

1. We are in the sixth and final week of our sermon series called Flawed but Faithful (the Story of Peter). Today's scripture reading is Acts 4:1-13. Here in the book of Acts we find the disciples, including Peter, being bold in their sharing of the good news of Jesus' resurrection. Take time to read it for yourself.
2. The disciples' bold declarations about Jesus are often right in the presence of a dangerous crowd of people in power, who strongly disagree with their message. They have come a long way from the disciples who scattered when Jesus was arrested. How bold would you say you are when it comes to sharing your faith?
3. The boldness of Peter appears to come from an overwhelming conviction of who Jesus is and what His death and resurrection meant. How well would you say you understand the core of the Gospel message? Could you explain it to someone?
4. If you are someone who wouldn't feel all that comfortable explaining the Gospel, what would it take for you to get more comfortable?
