Discussion Questions

1. A modern American Christmas is often defined by things like: where you need to travel to, what you need to bring, did you get the right presents in the car, what food are you going to eat, what food are you going to bring. The list can go on and on. Rush, rush, rush, busy, busy, busy. How typical of your average Christmas is that description? Would you say you typically have a rush, rush, rush, busy, busy, busy Christmas?

Christmas should be a time for us preparing ourselves for the coming of a Savior, but unfortunately for many Americans this season is more characterized by hurry, being overwhelmed, and consumerism. Has this year been any different for you? What's one tangible thing you could do to refocus on Jesus this Christmas?
3. Today we will be focusing on the Christmas Hymn "Go Tell it on the Mountain." Take a little time to look up this song and listen to it. What words or verses stand out to you as you listen? Do you have any memories tied to this song?
