Immerse week 4

Title: Immerse: Romans

Scripture Reading: Romans 8:35-39
Discussion Questions

- 1. We are now in the fourth week of our whole church New Testament Bible Reading Plan called Immerse. If you haven't started yet, it's not too late to join, grab a bookmark from the church Foyer and start reading along. If you have been reading this week what is one thing that stood out to you as you read? What was it like to read such a large chunk of scripture in one week?
- 2. This week we read the second half of Romans, plus a whole bunch of shorter books of the Bible. It would be impossible to cover all of these letters in one sermon, so to narrow down our focus today we are going to be looking at Paul's teaching in Romans 8:35-38. Read it for yourself, what stands out to you as you read?
- 3. "Who can separate us from the love of Christ? Shall hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? ... No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us." This quote from Romans 8:35-37 perfectly sums up this section of Paul's message. Have you ever felt separated from God's love? What was going on in your life that caused you to feel far from Him?
- 4. No matter what we have been through we are reassured that the things of this life have no ability to separate us from the love of Christ. Sometimes when we are going through difficult times it can be hard to see Christ, but if we look hard enough, He is there. Can you think of a time when you saw God come through even though you were going through something difficult? What was it like to know that God was by your side?
