Title: Heart of Worship: Give Me Jesus
Scripture Reading: Psalm 34:1-14

1. Today we are starting a new sermon series, “Heart of Worship.” Each week in this series the preacher will choose a worship song to focus on. These songs have been special to us, they have spoken words of truth, healing, peace, and love during some of life’s hard times, they have helped us say “yes” to God’s call or have given encouragement to prioritize Jesus above all else. If you selected a song like this, what song would you choose? Take some time to listen to your song, what is God speaking to you?
2. Today’s song is “Give Me Jesus.” Many artists have done this song, but possibly the most well-known version is from the artist Jeremy Camp. It’s a simple song about prioritizing Jesus above all other things. Are you familiar with this song? Look it up and listen to it again, what stands out to you as you listen to this song?
3. For modern Christians it feels like the things of this world are always competing for our attention and wanting to be the center of our lives. Work, Politics, Recreation, Relationships, everything is trying to take center stage. Scripture calls us to live Jesus-centered lives, looking to Him for fulfillment, meaning, and validation. What is an area of your life where you need to become more Jesus-centered?
4. Psalms 16:5 says: ‘LORD, are all I have, and you give me all I need; my future is in your hands’ Or as the song says, “You can have all this world, just give me Jesus.” What makes this a challenging prayer? Is this a prayer you are willing and able to pray? Why or why not?
