Same God Scripture Reading: Psalm 63:1-11 Discussion Questions

- 1. Today's sermon is entitled "Same God." Sometimes when we face big things in life we forget just how big and powerful our God is. God is mighty and God is great, it is that God that we cry out to in our times of need. Today's reading is Psalm 63:1-11. Take time to read it for yourself. What stands out to you as you read? What guestions do you have?
- 2. Malachi 3:6 reads "I the Lord do not change." and in the same way Hebrews 13:8 reads, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." What do these two verses mean to you in your spiritual walk? Do you find it encouraging to look at what God has done in the Bible and know that you follow the same God?
- 3. The Christian band Elevation Worship has a song called, "Same God." This song has some really powerful lyrics about how the God of the Bible is the same God we worship and follow today. He is still mighty, He is still powerful, and He is still making an impact in our world and in our lives. Take time to look it up online and listen to this song. What lines can you relate to?
- 4. When God shows up in our lives it's often called a mountaintop moment.
