- Kingdom Kids takes place during the sermon. Children 4 years- 5th grade go downstairs for their own time of discussion and activity. Kids can be picked up downstairs after the service.
- The Playground is for children and their families to remain in worship during the service and engage in sensory activities related to the sermon, as well as learn about what it is like to be in worship.

Our Youth Ministry exists to fan into flame what the Lord is doing among the 6th - 12th grade students in this region. We meet weekly on Sunday evenings from 6-7:30pm.
