- If nursery (ages 0-5) would be a blessing to you during worship, please reach out to Becky@sjpres.org to arrange care.


Youth Group

Discipleship Hour: The CHOSEN



The Parable of the Lost Sheep

15 Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. 2 But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

3 Then Jesus told them this parable: **4** "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninetynine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? **5** And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders **6** and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' **7** I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Prayer of Confession

Loving God, we confess how easy it is to justify or minimize our sin. Forgive us, Lord, when we, like sheep, go astray. Forgive us when we shun or exclude others by our words, actions, or attitudes.
