MOUNTAINS

READ MATTHEW 4:1-11

THE FOUR QUESTIONS

Spend time reading this passage and reflecting on these questions in order. Take some time to listen to what God is saying to you. How can this text help you regain a proper perspective of the world? In what areas do you need to be reminded to see Jesus as center of all things?

1. Who is God? What does this passage tell you about who God is?
2. What has He done? What do you see God doing in this passage? What work do you observe? How have you experienced this work in your life? How is what Jesus accomplished on that mountain incredibly significant for you?
3. Who are we? What does this passage tell you about your identity? Pastor Dean said “When Jesus said it is finished, grace was a reality for those who follow him.” Do you still carry guilt when Jesus has already made forgiven your new identity?
4. How do we live? When is the last time you read the Gospels and looked at the centrality of Jesus in all things? How can reminding yourself of the power and control of Jesus help you to be less anxious?
