



STUDY GUIDE MOUNTAINS

READ MATTHEW 4:1-11

THE FOUR QUESTIONS

Spend time reading this passage and reflecting on these questions in order. Think through all the explicit and implied statements about who God is, then what He has done, who we are, and how we should live. As you answer these questions, you can even connect them to each other. For example: If that's what God has done, who does that make me? And how do I live in light of that truth?

1. Who is God?

What does this passage tell you about God's character, motives, and identity (the Bible is about Him)?
What does each temptation and response tell us about who God is?

2. What has He done?

What do you see God doing in this passage?
What work do you observe?
How have you experienced this work in your life?
How is what Jesus accomplished on that mountain incredibly significant for you?

3. Who are we?

What does this passage tell you about your identity?
What does it mean to my identity that Jesus said no to Satan and yes to the cross?

4. How do we live?

How is God calling us to live based on who we are, what he has done, and who he is?
When you are tempted how do you respond?

PRAYER

Spend time with Jesus ask His guidance in facing your temptations, putting your trust in Him, understanding what it means to follow His way and spend eternity with Him.
