## Message Based Questions 11/1/20 Revelation – Part 5

## Icebreaker:

Scriptures: Revelation 2:1-7

## To Discuss:

- 1. What stands out to you from the message?
- 2. Take a quick scan over Revelation 1 and note all the titles of Jesus Christ. How is having this view of the glorified Jesus (or other themes in Revelation) deepening your worship and trust?
- 3. Read Revelation 2:1-7. What did Jesus say positively about the Ephesian church? Which of these do you display and which would you like to develop?
- 4. How are we to discern the difference between true and false teaching? Assign different group members to read the following: Acts 17:11; Romans 12:2; 1 Corinthians 12:3; Galatians 6:4-6; 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 5:14.
- 5. What did Jesus hold against the Ephesian church? The first and greatest commandment is to love the Lord your God completely (see Matthew 22:36-40). What are attitudes or actions that show a person has forsaken the first love that God commands?
- 6. What are some ways you express your love of God and your love of others? (see 1 John 3:16-19)
- 7. Three commands summarize Jesus' exhortation to the Ephesians: remember, repent and repeat. Which of these is the Holy Spirit tapping on your heart to do? What's your plan?
  - Remember love of Jesus and be amazed by God's grace extended to us;
  - Repent and turn away from false loves and be sorry enough to quit;
  - Repeat what you used to do; your motions will lead to emotion.
- 8. What is one thing you learned as a result of studying this passage or participating in this discussion? How can your group pray for you as you make this truth a part of your life?

Pray for a fresh realization of the love God has for you. As a result, may our love for Jesus be so compelling that it lovingly shines His truth in a dark world.
