Message Based Questions 9/13/20 Pride – Part 3

Scripture: Daniel 4-5

Icebreaker: Share a time you were embarrassed or humbled. AND/OR Share a crazy dream you've had recently!

Check-in: What has God been teaching you this week? Give updates on the practical applications you committed to last week, regarding forgiveness or pride.

DISCUSS:

- 1. Why is it hard to see ourselves at 3P people, characterized by power, prestige, and possessions?
- 2. What were some key verses in the story of Nebuchadnezzar as they relate to pride (see Daniel 4)? What can we learn from looking at his example?
- 3. Look up different verses that talk about God opposing the proud. What do you observe? One example is James 4:7, Amplified---
 - But He gives us more and more grace [through the power of the Holy Spirit to defy sin and live an obedient life that reflects both our faith and our gratitude for our salvation]. Therefore, it says, "God is opposed to the proud and haughty, but [continually] gives [the gift of] grace to the humble [who turn away from self-righteousness]."
- 4. In Daniel 5 we see Belshazzar ignoring the lesson of his grandfather. What was the meaning of what was written on the wall, "mene, mene, tekel, parsin" (v.25)? How is it significant for us?
- 5. Pastor Rick said "Every day I need to remember that ALL I have is stewardship." This isn't just his possessions but relationships, time, abilities and resources. How can we live with God-ordained perspective, regarded what we have been given?

PRAYER:

Spend a few minutes in quiet and ask God to show how to apply what's been covered today. Pray for a practical step you can take to walk in humility and root out pride. Ask your group to pray for you and check-in next week.
