Message-Based Questions <u>Searching for Happiness: Following the Shepherd</u> John 10:1-16

- 1. Have you ever seen someone undermine his or her own happiness, that the person could not see? Discuss.
- 2. What are some characteristics of sheep and shepherds? What is it about sheep that makes them a good representation of human beings?
- 3. Read John 10:7-11, What are some reasons its difficult for people to believe that Jesus wants them to have life "abundantly" or to the full?
- 4. Twice in this passage Jesus emphasizes the truth and importance of what he was saying. What core message did he want them to understand?
- 5. What is the context of this passage? What had just happened, and why is that important?
- 6. How are we to understand Jesus statement that "...he shall go in and out and find pasture"? Does this have any connection to the "abundant life" he mentions later?
- 7. Pastor Rick mentioned that eventually pleasure loses its pleasure and becomes a prison. Romans 6:16, is this difficult for you to understand? Why or why not?
- 8. How dependent are sheep on their shepherd? What do they need from him? How does this translate to our relationship to Jesus?
- 9. Is there a pleasure in your life that is stealing your freedom and undermining your happiness? If so what changes would you have to make? How can the group help support you?
- 10. Discuss the connection between dependency on Jesus and the kind of happiness we have been leaning about the past few weeks.
