Read Song of Songs 4:9-51, and 7:6-13, Ephesians 5:21-25

What surprises you the most in these passages?

If married, how are you guarding against marital unfaithfulness?

If married, how are you ensuring that nether lovemaking nor friendship is neglected in your relationship?

What do you think is the major difference between men's and women's perspectives about sex?

What does it mean to submit to one another? What is the motivation? How does that look in your current relationship?

How did Christ act on his "headship?"

If married, What is the next date night on the calendar for just the two of you?

If married, What are some of the main attributes you love about your spouse?

If married, get alone with your spouse this week and talk about the good memories you have about your past romance and lovemaking, and what are your hopes and dreams for the new delights yet to be enjoyed? (NOT to be answered in a group but alone separately!).

If single, what are the attributes you are looking for in a spouse? How are you becoming more like that person who are looking for?
