1 Corinthians 6:16-20, 1 John 1:9 and Psalm 103:12

What do you remember about the “sex talk” with your mom or dad? Who do you think felt more awkward, you or them?

1. If someone younger asked you for one piece of advice about sex, what would you tell him/her? What would you tell him/her about the purpose of sex?
2. Do you agree with the concept that sex isn't just physical? Why or why not? What experiences or evidence do you have that supports the idea that sex is more than physical?
3. What are some consequences of treating sex like any other physical act?
4. Paul defines sexual immorality as sex outside of marriage. Do you agree with this definition? In what ways is this standard trivialized in today's culture?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 6:18. What is the practical application of this verse? What does it look like in today's culture to “flee” sexual immorality?
6. Read 1 Corinthians 6:19–20. How does this view of our bodies/sexuality affect what we should believe and practice when it comes to sex and our desires?
7. Read 1 John 1:9 and Psalm 103:12, how can one apply these verses to any regrets and shame we might have when it comes to our sexuality?
