Message Based Questions 11/11/18 I Love My Church – Connecting

Who is someone that has personally helped you in your spiritual journey? How did they help you and do you think your journey would have looked different if this person would not have been there for you?

Review our key verse for the series: John 13:34-35. What did Jesus do for his disciples before these verses? How has Jesus loved you?

Read Hebrews 10:19-25.

How does Hebrews 10:22 remind you of your life before Christ?

What does it mean to you to not give up meeting together? Why is this so important in pursuing the Christian life?

How does and how can a group help you in your spiritual journey? How can you encourage others?

Why are both large gatherings (Sunday services) and small gatherings (groups) needed for our growth in Christ? (See Acts 2:46 and Acts 5:42)

Considering God's faithfulness to you, how do you show faithfulness to your church body or group? What difference does it make to your church or small group if you are committed to it?

Group check-in: Are we allowing each other into our hard places (letting people into your "back yard" as Pastor Rick talked about) so that true authentic community can grow? What can you do to help someone along in their spiritual journey?

What can you do personally to help someone connect to E-Free and maybe your group?

How is our group strategically fighting against being "us" centered?

What is your next step as a result of this message and discussion? What makes it hard to take the next step? Form that into a prayer and lift up each other.
