Discussion Questions:

- 1. If the towel could be seen as a sign of service in the first-century (i.e., Jesus washed the disciples' feet), what would be a sign of service in our culture today?
- 2. What obstacles get in the way of you living out a lifestyle of serving? How can you overcome them?
- 3. Share some of your observations from the Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:29-37).
- 4. Of the four things the Good Samaritan offered (his eyes, heart, time, possessions), which in your opinion was the most costly?
- 5. Is there ever a time that serving can be destructive rather than redemptive? Do you find it hard to say "No" to requests for help?
- 6. Are you willing to pray: "Jesus bring me someone today whom I can serve"? If not, what is an alternative prayer you will pray?
- 7. What is one thing you will apply to your life as a result of this message and discussion? Take time to pray through what each person has said. Use the daily Scripture readings for added study.
