Scripture: Micah 3:1-4, 6:4-8, Zechariah 7: 1-14, Matthew 25: 37-46

Zechariah passage

- What question did the delegation ask Zechariah? How did he reply?
- What was so wrong with the fasting and feasting these 70 years?
- Instead what should they have done to show justice and mercy?
- What attitude was in their heart? How did God react?

Matthew passage

- Does this story seem more like a parable or prophecy?
- How will Jesus divide humanity?
- What will Jesus say to those on his right? to his left?
- What does this passage teach you about our Christian responsibility?
- What criteria will Jesus use to judge people?

- Who are those in need around you?
- What resources do you have available to you for meeting the needs of the hurting?
- What is something practical that you can do this week to meet a need for someone who is an orphan, widow, immigrant?
