Message Based Questions 11/22/20 Revelation 3:1-6, Image over Substance

Icebreaker: What are you thankful for today?

To Discuss:

- 1. Looking back at your notes from the message, what caught your attention, or challenged or confused you?
- 2. Read Revelation 3:1-6. Revelation is primarily about Jesus. As you browse through this letter to the church at Sardis, what do you learn about Jesus our Lord?
- **3.** The church at Sardis had a good reputation, but were "dead". One of the key things that seems to be happening here is that they became satisfied with where they were as a church and became complacent. This, as is suggested by verse 3:1 is deadly! Think about and respond to the following:
 - a. How may the American church have become complacent? What perpetuated this?
 - b. Has the strife in our current culture added to complacency or muted it to some degree?
- **4.** How can we determine if we are living a Gospel-centered life? In addition to the three ways suggested in the message (see #6), what other ways can we encourage one another to be awake to what God is doing?
- **5.** Allow 10 minutes (or more) to work through these questions individually and then pair up or subgroup to discuss together.

Pastor Rick suggests these areas to evaluate:

REFLECT:

- What fears are driving you right now?
- What are you thankful for?
- Where is God working?
- How is your prayer life?
- What are you trusting Jesus for that is hard and beyond you?

REPENT (turn and go a different way)

- What changes need to be made?
- Where do I need to become more like Jesus?
- What steps to love God and love others can I take this week?

REACH

- Who are you praying for?
- Who are you cultivating a Gospel relationship with?
- What's your next step?
- **6.** What is one thing you learned as a result of studying this passage or participating in this discussion? How can your group pray for you as you make this truth a part of your life?
