What does his name change in this passage mean?

When you think about how you have wrestled with God in the past or even right now, what is your most common response?

What sorts of doubts do you wrestle with in your Christian faith? Can you name at least one? Where do you think this doubt comes from?

Are you ashamed of, proud of, or accepting of the doubts you have in your Christian faith? Why?

In spite of doubts you may have at this time, do you have enough faith in Jesus Christ to put your whole life and destiny in his hands? If so, how have you gotten to that point? If not, what holds you back?

Is there one particular way God has spoken to you through this message? If so how? And what does this make you suspect God is trying to do in your life at this time?
