Message Based Questions 10/11/20 Revelation – Part 2

Icebreaker: What activity causes you to think or feel like the time just flies by?

Scriptures: Revelation 1:1-3; Revelation 22:6-7, 12; Matthew 24:42-44; and more listed below

To Discuss:

- 1. What stands out to you from the message? What was a take-away for you?
- 2. Take turns reading the Scriptures listed below. Take time to pause and invite the Holy Spirit to teach and guide you. Which area is the most difficult for you?
 - Patient when going through hardships: James 1:2-4; Romans 8:28
 - Live a life of holiness: Romans 13:11-14 NLT
 - Live as a servant of the King: Revelation 1:1; John 12:26; Gal 5:13
 - Live as a testimony: John 15:27
- 3. Pastor Rick encourages us to see Revelation as a book about Jesus the Living King with invitations to live for Him intentionally now. Think back over your week and share a time you encouraged someone, shared Scripture, prayed, served, etc.
- 4. Some of the questions Pastor Rick posed for us were:
 - Where have you found or felt Jesus the most?
 - What part/area of your life do you need to get rid of unholy living?
 - God, how are you leveraging my pain and suffering?

Pick one to answer or comment on.

- 5. Is living with a sense of urgency a new concept for you? Who can you share this message with or invite them to attend next week in-person or online?
- 6. Who is in your circle of contacts that has yet to accept Jesus? Spend time praying for them for a softening of their heart and an opening for you to share the hope and love of God.
