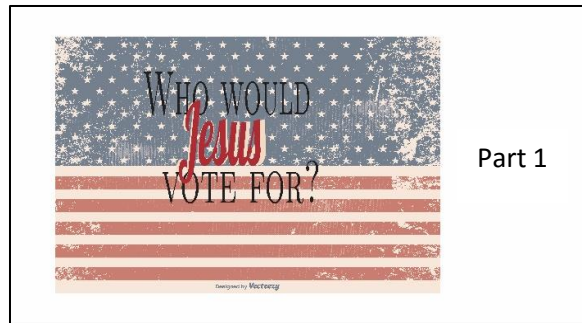

*Read Daniel 4:1-37*

1. How does the interpretation of the king's dream relate to issues of pride, arrogance and humility especially in light of powerful leadership?
2. The Aramaic word for righteous or what is right, links human responsibility to both God and neighbor. Why does Daniel stress both? (How is being kind to the oppressed a witness to God?)
3. King Nebuchadnezzar realized that leadership is a stewardship, it is temporary and we are accountable to God for how we lead. How does that reality influence you and your support of a candidate in this political process? How does this truth influence the way you will lead in your current leadership role?
4. How can we look for character, competency and humility this election season? How does that play into your decision process in voting for a president or any leader?
5. When was the last time you stopped and prayed for the candidates and teams of both sides? Will you commit to that over the next few months?
