DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Think about some popular movies, TV shows, songs, and websites. Based on what you are seeing and reading, what are some current rules in our culture regarding love, sex, and relationships? Which of them do you agree with? Disagree?
2. According to our passage, What are some of the key characteristics of love?
3. What does Pastor Rick mean by great sex begins in the kitchen?
4. What is the "right person myth"? Do you agree that it is a myth? How have you seen this way of thinking impact your relationships or those of your friends?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-5. In this passage, we find a list of qualities that are characteristic of the "right person." Which of these qualities is the most difficult for you to exhibit? Which quality do you value most in someone you want to date, your spouse, or significant other?

Challenge:

- Becoming the person who the person you are looking for is looking for is hard. Think about a couple of things you can do this week to become that person—the right person, whether you are single or whether you are married.
