## Message Based Questions 8/23/20 Politics & Religion – Part 4

## Passages: John 13:34-35, Galatians 3:26-28

- 1. The power of one verse (1 John 2:6) impacted Pastor Rick this week. Which verse is speaking to you lately? How can you encourage one another to be in God's Word regularly?
- 2. Look at Galatians 3:26-28 and read out loud. How would these verses have been hard to believe in the first Century?
- 3. When we love well and are unified, it paints a picture of Jesus to the rest of the world. How do we do this practically in our families, small groups, and neighborhoods?
- 4. Big question for this series has been Are we willing to put our faith filter over our political filter? Discuss how you can encourage one another in this area.
