Connect Sunday

Scripture: Mark 3:14, Acts 2:42-47 (MSG version), John 13:34-35, Mark 10:45

- 1) What did you find the most challenging or helpful about the message?
- 2) The main idea for the morning is that life and discipleship happens best in circles versus rows. What factors fight against connecting with one another? How can we overcome them?
- 3) Pastor Rick cautioned us about the tendency to isolate and be selfish. What are ways we as the Body of Christ can love God and love others more fully?
- 4) We are created to be in community with others to love so others will see God! Refer to the Acts 2:42-47 passage. What stands out? How would you summarize the point for us today?
- 5) Serving one another puts to death our selfishness, which is the root of all sin. Have you seen serving do this for you and your group? If your group has not served together recently, make plans to do something in the near future!

Application: Spend time in worship and prayer thanking Jesus that He modeled connecting with others and humbly serving. He gave the ultimate sacrifice of His life for us! Pray for us as a church family to put to death our sin and to love God and others like Jesus modeled.
