I love you this much!

We like to hear the words, "I love you."

But they lose their meaning if we don't see them in action.

The Apostle John wrote: "Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." (1 John 3:18)

GOD's Story— Do You Love Me? John 21:15-19

Agape $\alpha\kappa\alpha\pi\eta$ = selfless love demonstrated by action (concept absent in ancient Greek before N.T.) Phileo $\delta\iota\lambda\epsilon\omega$ = tender affection

1. Jesus: "Do you love (agape $\alpha\gamma\alpha\pi\alpha\zeta$) me?"

Peter: "Yes Lord, you know that I love (phileo $\varphi\iota\lambda\omega)$ you."

Jesus: "Feed my lambs."

2. Jesus: "Do you love (agape $\alpha \gamma \alpha \pi \alpha \zeta$) me?"

Peter: "Yes Lord, you know that I love (phileo $\phi \iota \lambda \omega$) you."

Jesus: "Take care of my sheep."

3. Jesus: "Do you love (phileo φιλειζ) me?"

Peter: "Yes Lord, you know all things, you know that I love (phileo $\phi\iota\lambda\omega$) you."

Jesus: "Feed my sheep." ("BTW, You will honor me in your death.") "Follow me (anyway)."

Jesus: "OK Peter, we'll start where you are. If affection for me is all you can muster, we'll start there. I still love you! I still want you! But you're not getting out of the work—your calling—Feed My Sheep!"

What did	you discover	in this stor	у?	?

BIG Idea:

Jesus will always meet you where you are, but he wants to take you to a new, higher place. Your love for him must be *agape*, demonstrated by obedience.

He wants you to *feed his sheep*. Are you?
