1. Paul's Experience, 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

What Suffering Does:

- Reveals our weakness
- Makes us dependent on God's grace
- Allows us to experience God's power
- Makes us strong

2. Our Response to Suffering, 1 Peter 5:5b-11

What God Wants:

- Humble Ourselves!
- Give our anxiety to him
- Be alert and sober...
- Resist the Devil
- Stand Firm—you are not alone in your suffering!
- God's Promise: He will restore you, make you strong, firm & steadfast

Big Idea:

Bad News: Suffering is part of the deal! It's the only way to prevent conceit in us.

Good News: God uses suffering to make us humble and dependent on him for our strength.
God's purpose in our suffering is always something good!
