- 1. Black Marks in Israel's History
 - Idolatry: The Golden Calf, Exodus 32
 - Sexual Immorality, Numbers 25

 - Grumbling, Numbers 21

Why were these embarrassing historical events preserved?

- o To keep us from the same evil 1 Corinthians 10:6
- o To warn us who live in this critical time, 1 Corinthians 10:11

2. Nehemiah's Example of Handling His People's Sins of the Past, Nehemiah 1

- He recognized Jerusalem's current plight was due to Israel's sin.
- He confessed Israel's sin, even though he was not a part of it.
- He did not return to Jerusalem to tear down, her returned to rebuild!
