Principle #5: We seek the good of others, not our own good. 1 Cor. 10:23-33

God's Story 1 Cor. 10:23-33

Paul says that he can do whatever he wants to but not all things are beneficial or edifying. He has the <u>right</u> --- NKJV says all things are <u>lawful</u>. Is Paul is putting the statutes of God above the law, his rights, flag, vote, mask and race ... voluntarily??

How do we get to place of seeking the well being of others above ourselves?

- -Become a real Jesus Follower Jesus came to seek and save that which was lost
- -Allow yourself to be stretched in love and increase your capacity to love
- -Get close enough to people to identify their needs, hurts, frustrations, thoughts opinions etc
- -Intentionally try to fulfill those needs, heal hurts, calm frustrations

1 Cor 13:5

Love does not seek its own--- if I am seeking my own that is NOT a manifestation of love

Who do we know who's described as love??

1 John 4:7-21

Do we really know God or do we just know of him. Have we placed other gods in front of the almighty God?

The big idea:

When we constantly seek our own benefit and the not benefit of others we enter into the arena of pride --- pride is the appetizer to destruction – so while we're busy arguing and being divided we are actually adding ingredients to a meal of destruction. Stop Hurting-Start Loving

That's whats up!!!
